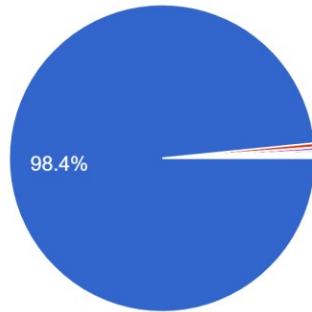

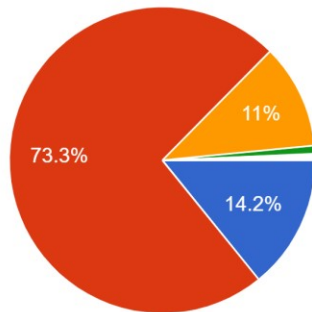

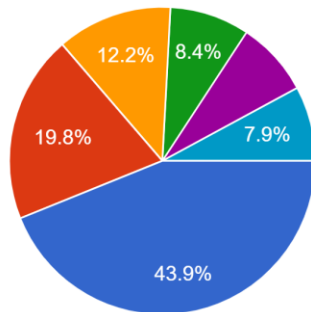

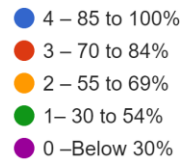
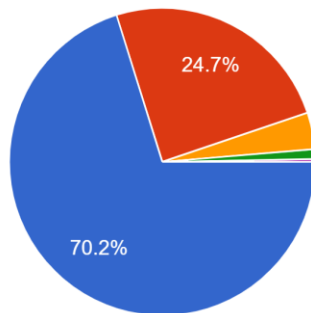

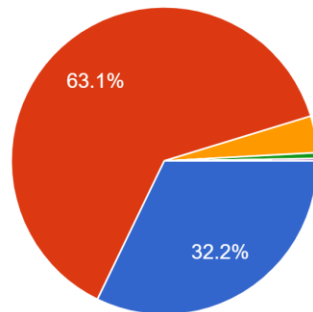
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

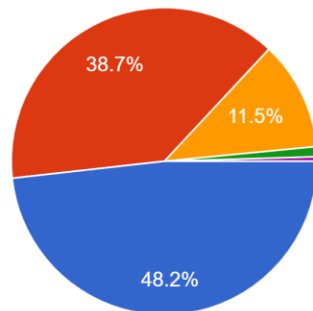

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

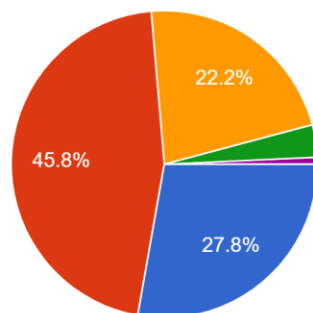

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

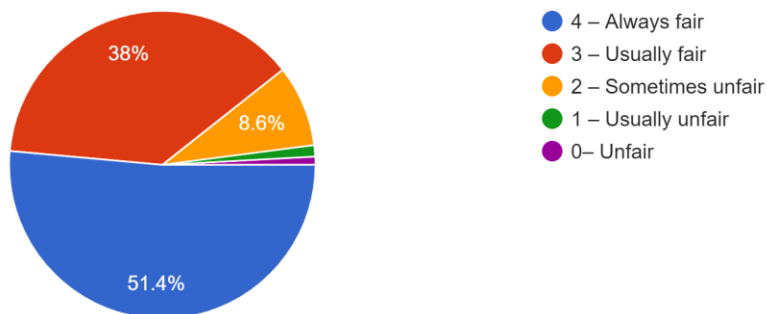

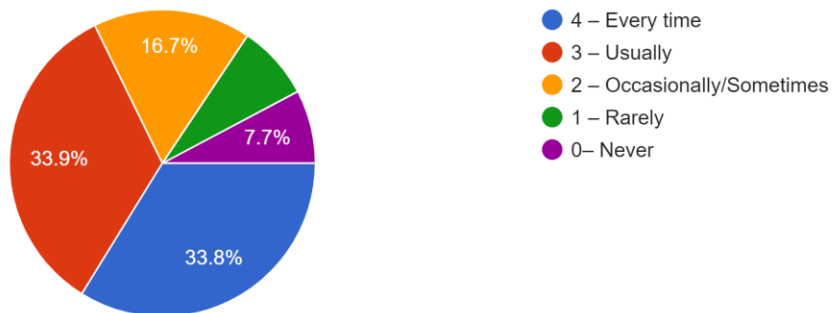
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation (class test/project) process by the teachers.

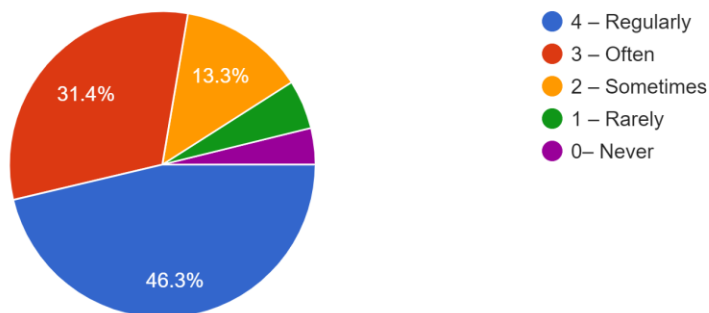
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

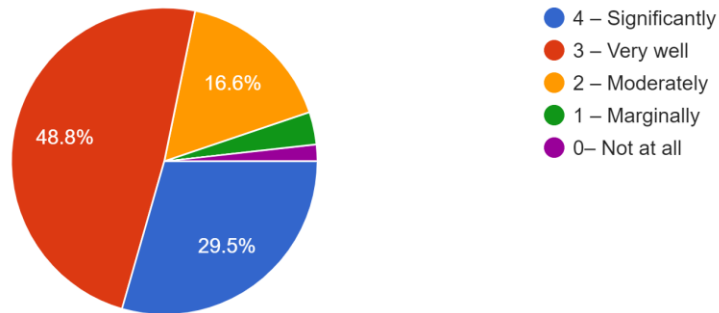

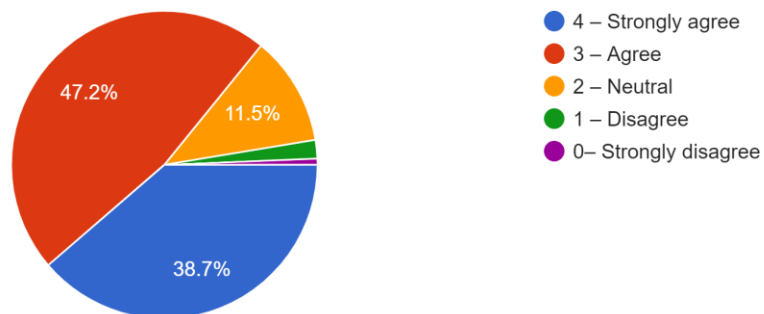
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive (thinking), social and emotional growth.

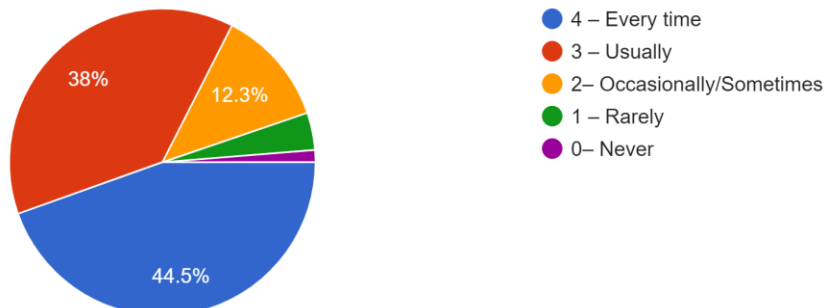

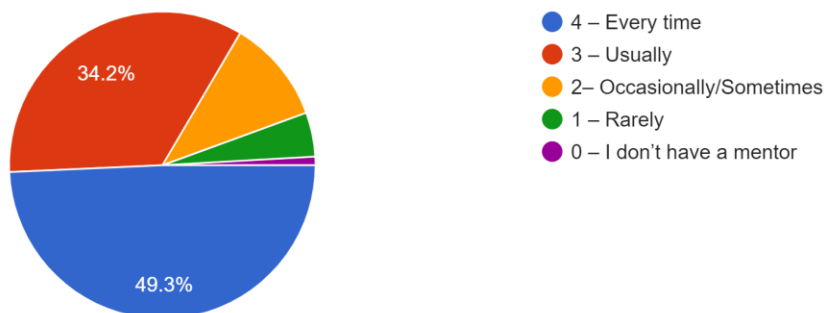

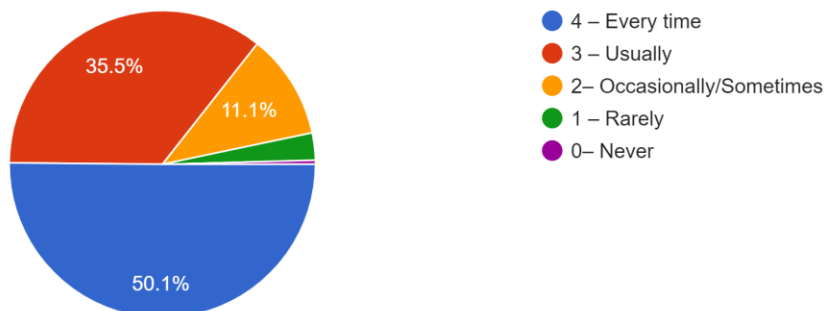

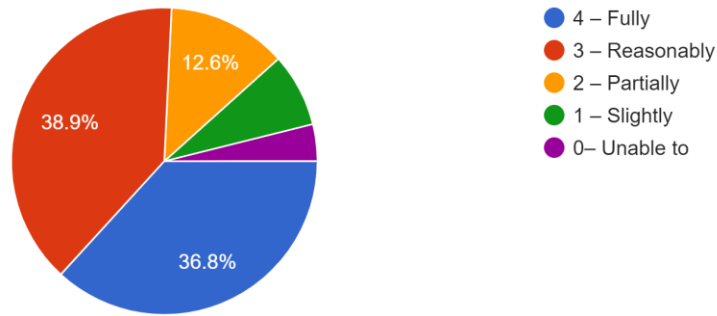

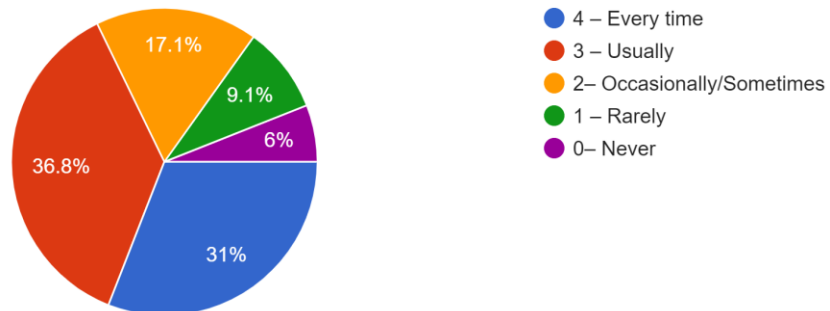

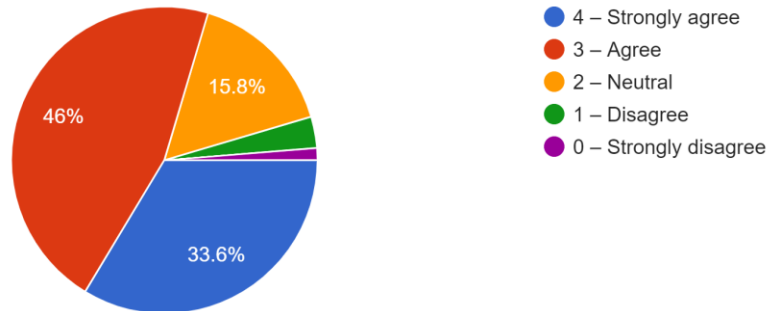

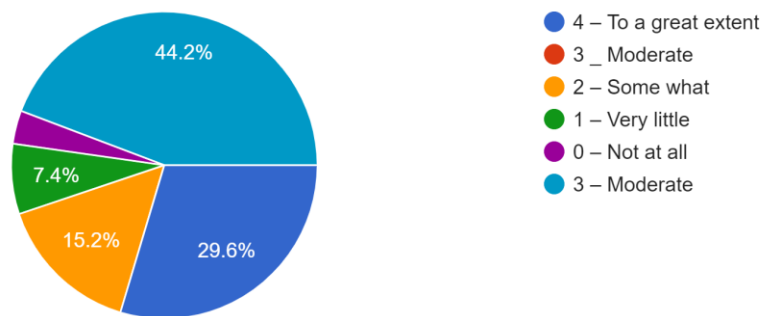

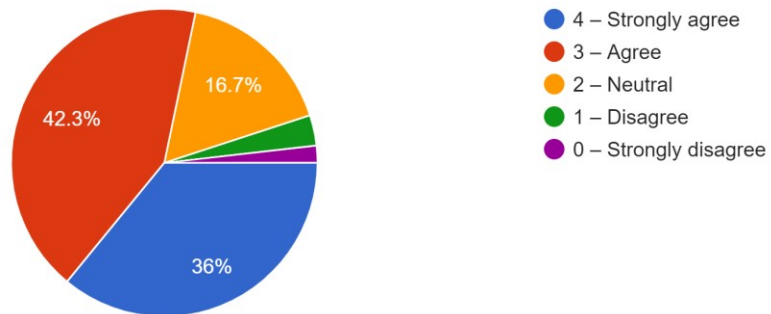

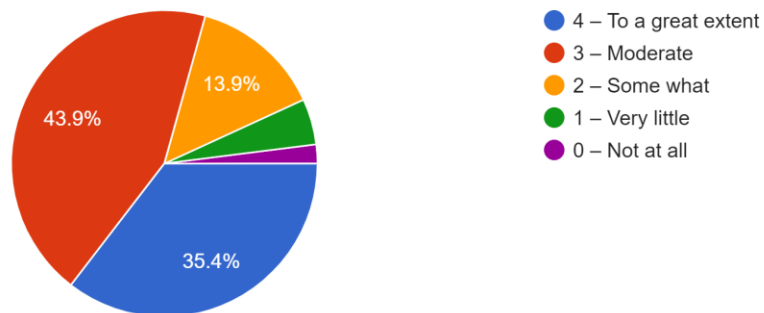

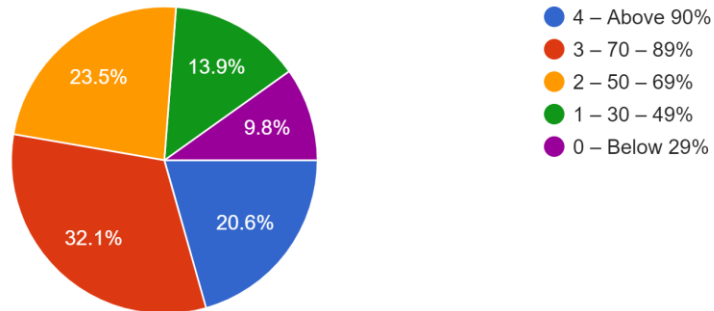
