

- (1) One Professor and two Assistant Professors must be appointed by 1.1.1995 for each discipline.
- (2) 10% of the faculty must be given opportunity for upgradation of qualifications/professional development.
- (3) Various laboratories must be strengthened with additional equipment.
- (4) A qualified Principal must be appointed as per AICTE norms and guidelines.
- (5) The Management including the Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted and the Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.

- (6) No new courses shall be started or an on-going course shall approval of the AICTE.

- (9) All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities time.
- (10) Teaching and other staff shall be seleted according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
- (11) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Severnment within the overall criteria/limits
- (12) The institution shall not charge any capitation fee or admission or other higher charges from the students in any form.
- (13) Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the ALUTE.

- (15) Institution by virtue of the approval of the AICIE shall not assistance from the Central or State Bovernment.
- (16) Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as

- (18) The institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the ALUIE.
- (19) Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICIE for ensuring maintenance of

- (20) The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.
- (21) The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the ALCIE. There shall be an evaluation of the institution in a plan period by the ALCIE.
- (22) The Institution must submit a duly registered undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper torwards fultilment of conditions in the standard format.

In the event of non-compliance of the guidelines, norms and standards prescribed by the AICTE, the AICTE shall be tree to take measures for withdrawal of the approval without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Trust/Society and/or the institution.

This approval is further subject to full compliance with the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 on W.P.(C) No. 507 of 1992 with other WPs in the case of Unnikhishnan, J.P. and other etc. etc. vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, USC or the Central Sovernment from time to time.
